## President's Report: Your College in 2009 & Beyond



President David Cole

I'd like to update you on our progress thus far, in each area:

**Goal 1:** *Fulfill our mission through continual development of academic programs and integration of academic learning, Christian character development and practical ministry experience.* We have been earnestly reviewing all of our programs and reshaping them not only for cultural relevance, but also to intentionally build into all of our offerings the integrated EBC experience: Learn—Grow—Lead. We are also engaged in research that might lead to new program offerings that allow us to expand the ways in which we fulfill our mission, and offer additional ways for our graduates to take the Gospel to a new generation.

**Goal 2:** *Maintain current levels of accreditation and achieve regional accreditation with the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities.* Our membership in the Association for Biblical Higher Education has been renewed, and we continue as candidates for accreditation with the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. In the fall of 2009 we will host an evaluation team on campus, after we have completed a self-study report for them. We have received positive reviews thus far, although we are reporting on our necessary progress in the areas of greatest concern to the commissioners, enrollment and finances.

**Goal 3:** *Increase the base of financial resources and maximize current and incoming resources to enhance the support of students, personnel*

*and facilities.* With the help of Jason Burke, EBC's Director of Community Relations, we are building stronger relationships with businesses and churches, particularly in the Pacific Northwest. We are also researching ways to begin strengthening the College's general endowment fund in order to bring long-term stability and strength to our campus.

**Goal 4:** *Strengthen recruiting and retention efforts to increase student completion numbers.* Admissions Director Sarah Maestas and Recruiting Director Nathan Icenhower are leading our student recruitment team, with wonderful results this year. Our accepted student list for fall 2009 is more than double what it was at this time last year.

**Goal 5:** *Provide an operational student life center as a key component of a comprehensive campus development plan.* We are delighted with the many wonderful activities taking place in the first year of operation for our new Rexius Event Center. With athletic and recreational activities in Cordeiro Court, chapels and drama productions in Stewart Chapel, an ongoing celebration of our heritage in the Open Bible Heritage Center, and numerous special events that have touched the lives of thousands already, we are truly blessed. We expect to soon be hosting our first summer camping events for children, and our capacity to serve and minister to others has significantly expanded.

These are challenging days for our nation, and we know that the EBC community is not immune to the adjustments that are necessary as our economy attempts to take its toll on us. Prospective and current students and their families, alumni, sponsoring churches, and individual and corporate friends of the College are all assisting us as we find creative ways to both survive and thrive. We at EBC thank you for standing with us through thick and thin, and we are committed to being here for you in the years to come, as we follow the Lord's direction in faith and obedience.
