## Annual President's Report

### How Are We Doing?

I'm so glad you asked! Please allow me to share a few thoughts about the current state

of affairs at Eugene Bible College in this year's edition of the annual President's Report. We are now in our second year of progress in fulfilling the goals set in our EBC Vision 2011 strategic plan. Here are a few highlights:

- After so many years of prayer, hard work, and sacrificial giving that has included so many of you, we are on the verge of completing our new Student Life Center. Praise the Lord! We will be dedicating our new facility on Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> as part of our Reconnect alumni weekend. Our students will begin the 2008-09 college year with so many new options: a bigger and better chapel auditorium, a gymnasium, new classrooms, and much more.
- By the time you read this, we will have successfully hosted a site visit by an evaluation team from the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. This is the first of three anticipated

evaluation visits since we were granted candidacy status with the commission. This status (candidacy) is not regional accreditation, but is a necessary step in that potential direction. Along the way we are maintaining our standing with the U.S. Department of Education through our accreditation with the Association for Biblical Higher Education. We'll keep you posted on our progress as we continue to work toward making EBC the strongest possible Christian education institution in the fulfillment of our mission.

- We are recruiting new students and working hard to serve our current ones. Scott Thomas, Dannette DeLaMatter and Kristin Hedman have been an outstanding admissions team, and our student outreach groups continue to find themselves in both new and familiar surroundings as we make new friends among prospective students while keeping the old!

- Speaking of new friends, we hosted over 200 from the Eugene area last fall at the Hilton hotel for our first Reaching Our Community banquet. Including testimonies from students and alumni and featuring Rear Admiral Robert Burt (EBC Class of '78), the event is an example of how the College has more intentionally been cultivating

its partnerships with those in our various spheres of influence, even as we faithfully share the love of Christ with those in our midst. We are already excited about our second Reaching Our Community event this fall on October 18.

- In the midst of these specific efforts, EBC continues to work to provide an integrated experience for our students, one that includes excellent classroom instruction from a caring and competent Christian faculty, a focus on character development coordinated by our Student Ministries and Discipleship office, and leadership and ministry skill training through a variety of field work opportunities. Students have been challenged in chapel services this year by nationally recognized speakers such as Wayne Cordeiro and Stephen Mansfield, as well as by a diverse group of local pastors and Christian leaders. We are indeed equipping our students for Spirit-empowered leadership and ministry! So, EBC continues to be faithful to its founding purposes, even as we keep finding new methods to accomplish them.

We look forward to another year that will bring creativity and innovation as we partner with new friends and advance the Kingdom of God in more effective ways.

Of course, changes and transitions occur along the way. On that note, I want to say a word of thanks to Trent Combs, who has moved on to work with a parachurch ministry in Lake Oswego, Oregon, after twenty years of effective ministry at EBC. ## Deacon Athletic Teams Finish Season Strong



**B**oth the women's volleyball and men's basketball teams finished their winter schedules on winning notes. Ruth Beck, volleyball coach, guided the women's volleyball team to a 9-1 season, the best in recent history, finishing first in the City of Eugene league. Coach Beck indicated this season was truly a team effort. The successful season was highlighted by the leadership of senior Kristin Hedman and freshman starter Megan Carr. Congratulations to the 2008 women's volleyball team and Coach Beck.

The 2007-2008 Deacon men's basketball team finished the season with three consecutive wins. Coach Gabe Combs reports the team continued to improve throughout the year and developed a strong team spirit that was the catalyst to ending the season strong and finishing with a 6-7 overall record. Led by graduating senior Ben Rushing the Deacons tied or set seven all-time team records and tied or set thirteen individual player records. Most noteworthy team records are the highest field goal percentage for a season and three blocked shot records. Additionally, Josiah Kellerman tied or set four records (one blocked shot record tied with Andy Cannell), one for highest 3-field goals percentage for a game and three for blocked shots. 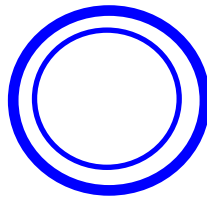
